### ABORIGINAL SPORT CIRCLE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Aboriginal Sport Circle (ASC) is seeking nominations for its Board of Directors. Serving on the Board is an opportunity to help shape the future of Indigenous sport, physical activity, recreation, and traditional games across Canada through strong governance, strategic leadership, and collaboration.

### POSITIONS AVAILABLE

The following positions are available for a two-year term beginning immediately following the Annual General Meeting on September 16, 2026:

- One (1) Vice-President
- Three (3) Directors

ASC welcomes nominations from qualified individuals across Canada who are committed to advancing Indigenous sport and community well-being. Preference will be given to qualified First Nations, Inuit, and Métis candidates. ASC also encourages nominations from women, persons with disabilities, members of the 2SLGBTQI+ community, and people of all gender identities and expressions.

### NOMINATION PACKAGE

A complete nomination package must include:

- A completed nomination form
- A current résumé or curriculum vitae (CV)
- One personal or professional reference letter
- One PTASB reference letter
- A short nomination video
